MosKeyTool is an interactive identification key for mosquito species (4th stage larvae and female specimens) of the whole Euro-Mediterranean area. This comprehensive basis covers 128 mosquito species. This user-friendly tool is freely downloadable and can be easily installed on your computer.

WHAT IS MosKEYTOOL ?

> An interactive identification key for mosquitoes of the Euro-Mediterranean area

MosKeyTool is intended to help non-entomologists and expert users for identifying the species of a mosquito specimen.

Taxonomic data

- For adult female and 4th stage larva
 - A single basis for genus and species identification
 - 128 species of Culicidae belonging to 7 genera: *Aedes*, *Anopheles*, *Coquilletidia*, *Culex*, *Culiseta*, *Orthopodomyia*, *Uranotaenia*
 - 143 morphological criteria.
- No molecular or genetic criteria are taken into account. Therefore the identification process stops at complex level.
- Pictures, illustrations and descriptions
 - MosKeyTool is based on the CD-ROM: *The Mosquitoes of Europe*, IRD Editions, 2001, and *The Mosquitoes of Mediterranean Africa*, IRD Editions, 2000.

Geographical area

- Western palearctic biogeographic region including Europe, Atlantic and Mediterranean Islands, Northern Africa, South Caucasus and part of the Middle-East.



- 66 geographical units
- Most of the time, the countries are used as geographical unit. However the main islands or isolated archipelago are also used as geographic unit.

Software

- Developed with the Xper2 version 2.3.2, a free software dedicated to computer-aided-identification
- MosKeyTool version V1.1 is available in English since May, 2017.
- To be used offline

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WHO ARE MOSKEYTOOL END USERS?

Mosquitoes caused many public health problems around the Mediterranean area:

- transmission of human diseases or animal pathogens;
- proliferation of certain species that induces nuisance;
- medical threat due to the introduction of potential vector exotic species such as *Aedes albopictus* (widespread and abundant in the Mediterranean basin), *Aedes japonicus* (France, Germany, Serbia...), *Anopheles* species in airports...

MosKeyTool facilitates the mosquito species identification and can help research and teaching in medical entomology. This software is required as soon as a precise morphological identification of the species is needed.

This identification interactive tool was developed mainly to **public health professionals -teachers, students, medical entomologists, parasitologists, and all human or veterinary health agents in charge of surveillance and control of mosquitoes.**

Mosquito surveillance as well as its environmental impact imply a precise knowledge of their ecology and behavior.

> A tool for teaching medical entomology

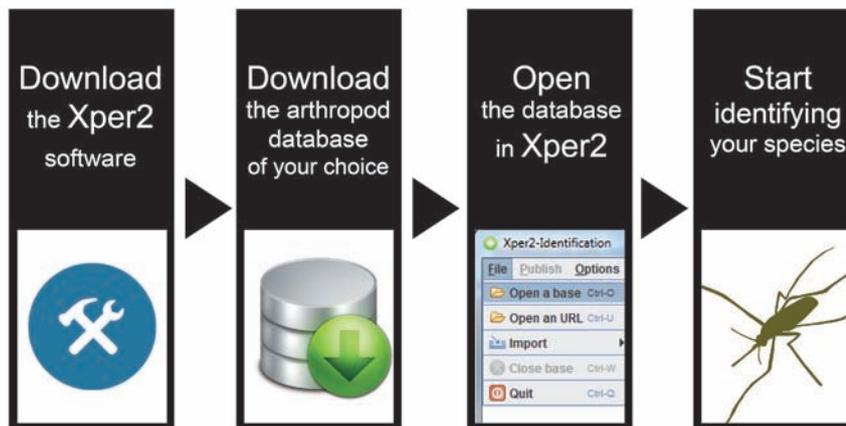
This software gives synthetic and up-to-date information on the distribution and medical or veterinary role of mosquito species. It can be used as a supporting material for (self)learning and teaching the morphology and taxonomy of mosquitoes (Diptera: Culicidae).

> A tool for applied research

MosKeyTool is an upgraded synthesis of all the morphologic and taxonomic knowledge in the whole Euro-Mediterranean region. It can help any actor researching on transmission of pathogens, inventory of species, mosquito ecology, etc.



HOW TO INSTALL MosKEYTOOL ?



STEP 1: Download and install the Xper2 software

STEP 2: Download the MosKeyTool database



Extract the zip archive inside a directory, you must have 1 folder and 4 files:

- folder « images» file «moskeytool_V1.1.xpd»
- file «moskeytool_V1.1.xpx»
- file «moskeytool_V1.1.xpw»
- file «moskeytool_V1.1.xpr»

STEP 3: Open the Xper2 software

Go to **File** -> **Open a Database** and select the file «moskeytool_V1.1.xpd»

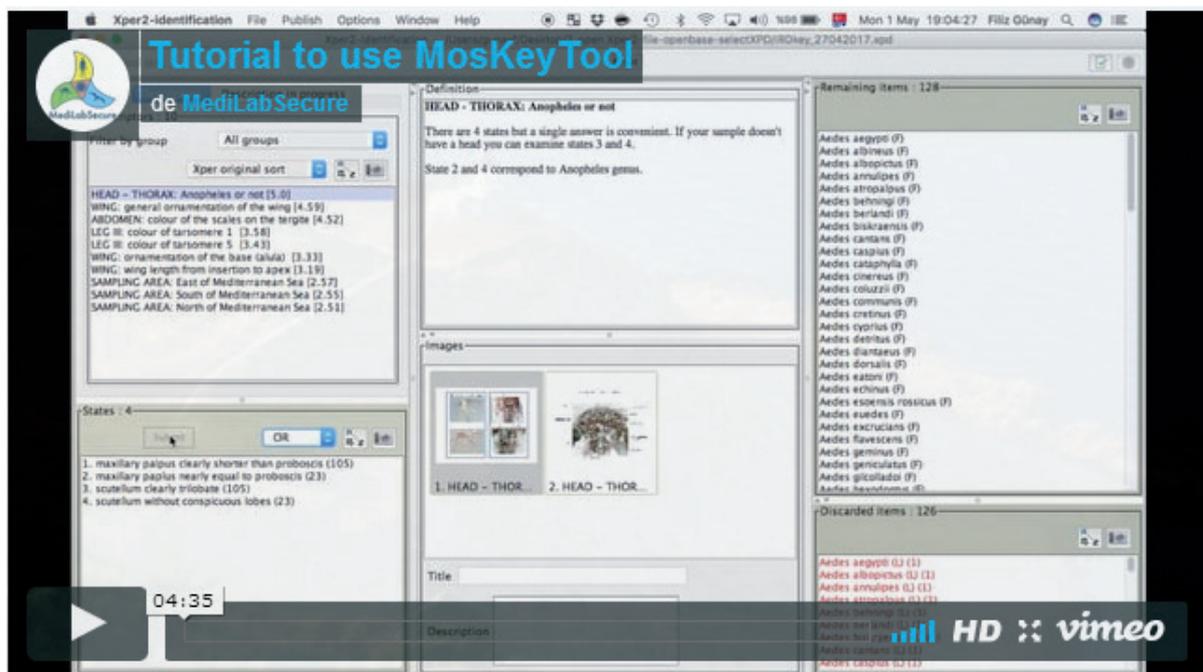
HOW TO USE MosKEYTOOL ?
