






















Global reduction of risks/threats due to Chemical, Biological, Radiological and Nuclear materials

 - International organizations (UNICRI, WHO, BWC, etc.)













- > Strengthening CBRN legal framework
- > Improving CBRN capacities of first responders
- Capacity building for CBRN detection
- > Improving CBRN waste management
- > Building CBRN forensics capacities
- Strengthening CBRN border control
- Better capacities for dual use export control
- > Training & guidance for biosafety and biosecurity
